

GILES COUNTY SUMMER YOUTH WORK PROGRAM – TRAINING APPLICATION 2021

Description: A collaborative program between Giles County Public Schools, the New River/Mount Rogers Workforce Investment Area, the Giles County Industrial Development Authority, the Giles County Board of Supervisors and the Giles business community. The goal is to provide students with practical work experience and increase their future employability skills and earnings potential. Opportunities will be available in occupational areas such as agriculture, technology, retail, food service, manufacturing and others with numerous local job sites. The program does not screen or have control over other persons who may be employed or working at the worksites.

Number of Participants: Up to 45 students will be selected

Minimum Age: At least 16 years old by June 14, 2024.

Pay: Minimum wage of \$9.50/hour

Start/End Date: June 14, 2021 – July 24, 2021

Number of Work Hours/Week: A total of no more than **192 total hours** is allowed. The worksite and worker will schedule how those hours are spent.

Transportation: Parent/Student Responsibility

Eligibility: A student must be willing to work hard, follow directions and demonstrate reliable attendance as evidenced by school records. The student must reside in Giles County for a least one year. **The student must complete this application and return it to their school office no later than April 15th, 2021.** Job interviews are scheduled at NHS on April 21st and GTC on April 22nd and 23rd. There will be a mandatory Parents/Student Night at GTC on Tuesday, June 8th, 6:00pm. Students/parents will be notified, beginning in the week of May 10th, 2021, regarding their placement site.

NOTE: It is imperative that any applicant who has found other employment between the interview and placement, notify Program Manager Jeff Dinger at Giles County (921-2525) ASAP so that time and effort will not be spent on placement activities for that student.
