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# ***WHAT WE OFFER. . . . .***

## **Automotive Service Technology**

\*Program is ASE certified in 6 of 8 areas.

## **Building Trades**

\*Option to take NCCER Core Curriculum, Carpentry I, Electrical I, Plumbing I, Masonry I Certification Exams.

## **Computer Systems Technology**

\*Dual Enrollment program with New River Community College.  
- 12 Credits

## **Drafting/Pre-Engineering**

\*Dual Enrollment program with New River Community College.  
- 8 Credits

Students will take the American Design Drafting Association Certification

## **Cosmetology**

\*Students are required to take the state Board of Cosmetology exam at the end of the program.



## **Licensed Practical Nursing**

\*18 month program for seniors only. Students are required to take Nursing Assistant to be admitted into the Practical Nursing program. A pre-entrance test is given prior to admission. This test measure reading comprehension and math skills. An acceptable pre-set score must be met to enter into the Practical Nursing program.

## **Machine Technology**

\*Dual Enrollment program with New River Community College.  
- 9 Credits

Students will take industry certification exams from the National Institute for Metalworking Skills Level I.

## **Welding**

\*Students will pass a 10 hour OSHA safety training course. Students will take certification exam at the end of course.

## **Nursing Assistant**

\*1 year only program in either 11th or 12th grade. Dual Enrollment program with New River Community College.  
- 4 Credits
