

GILES COUNTY SUMMER YOUTH WORK PROGRAM – TRAINING APPLICATION

Description: A collaborative program between Giles County Public Schools, the New River/Mount Rogers Workforce Investment Area, the Giles County Industrial Development Authority, the Giles County Board of Supervisors and the Giles business community. The goal is to provide students with practical work experience and increase their future employability skills and earnings potential. Opportunities will be available in occupational areas such as agriculture, technology, retail, food service, manufacturing and others with numerous local job sites.

Number of Participants: Up to 50 students will be selected

Minimum Age: At least 16 years old by June 13, 2016.

Pay: Minimum wage of \$7.25/hour

Start/End Date: June 13, 2016 – July 23, 2016

Number of Work Hours/Week: Average of 32 (Four 8 hour days/week or a total of 192 hours)

Transportation: Parent/Student Responsibility

Eligibility: A student must be willing to work hard, follow directions and demonstrate reliable attendance as evidenced by school records. **The student must complete this application and return it to Mrs. Vaden at the Tech. Center no later than April 1st, 2016.** Job interviews will be scheduled at the school for April 12th, 13th & 14th. Students/parents will be notified beginning the week of May 8th, 2016 if accepted into the program.

NOTE: It is imperative that any applicant who has found other employment notify Program Manager Jeff Dinger at Giles County (921-2525) ASAP so that time and effort will not be spent on placement activities for that student.
